## **Privacy Policy**

Your privacy is important to us.

We will collect, hold and use your personal information as permitted by this policy and relevant privacy law.

This policy sets how we collect, hold and use personal information.

#### **Collecting Personal Information**

When you communicate with us, visit our website, instruct us, ask us for advice, request that we send you newsletters and/or other materials or otherwise engage with us we gather your personal information.

Personal information we collect from you may be needed in order for us to assist you.

### **Collecting General Information**

- meet our legal obligations (including the laws of foreign jurisdictions), for example, compliance with anti-money laundering and countering financing of terrorism legislation, and our obligations to the New Zealand Law Society
- send you publications we think you might be interested in
- invite you to webinars, seminars and events
- carry out internal business/administrative functions, for example, sending out invoices and receipts and recovering money owed to us (we may disclose information to third party debt collection agencies).

We may disclose your personal information to third parties who help us provide services or who do work for us or on our behalf.

#### The Internet

The internet is not a secure environment. Any information you send us over the internet is sent at your own risk. Never send bank account or credit card information over the internet including by email.
